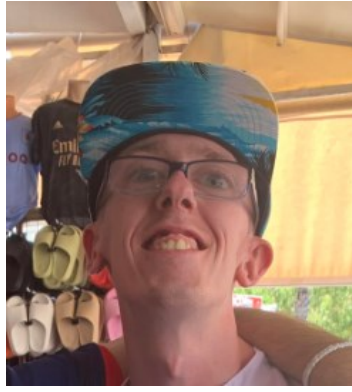


Oliver's Sponsored Swim
